Westminster Larger Catechism 34 How was the covenant of grace administered under the Old Testament? A. The covenant of grace was administered under the Old Testament, by promises,(1) prophecies,(2) sacrifices,(3) circumcision,(4) the pass-over,(5) and other types and ordinances, which did fore-signify Christ then to come, and were for that time sufficient to build up the elect in faith in the promised Messiah,(6) by whom they then had full remission of sin, and eternal salvation.(7) (1)Rom. 15:8. (2)Acts 3:20,24 (3)Heb. 10:1 (4)Rom. 4:11 (5)1 Cor. 5:7 (6)Heb. Chapters VIII, IX and X; Heb. 11:13. (7)Gal. 3:7,8,9,14.

ESV **Exodus 12:11-14; 24-27** ¹¹It is the LORD's Passover. ¹²For I will pass through the land of Egypt that night, and I will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and on all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments: I am the LORD. ¹³The blood shall be a sign for you, on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you, when I strike the land of Egypt. ¹⁴"This day shall be for you a memorial day, and you shall keep it as a feast to the LORD; throughout your generations, as a statute forever, you shall keep it as a feast...²⁴ You shall observe this rite as a statute for you and for your sons forever. ²⁵And when you come to the land that the LORD will give you, as he has promised, you shall keep this service. ²⁶And when your children say to you, "What do you mean by this service?" ²⁷you shall say, "It is the sacrifice of the LORD's Passover, for he passed over the houses of the people of Israel in Egypt, when he struck the Egyptians but spared our houses.

Westminster Larger Catechism 35 How is the covenant of grace administered under the New Testament? A. Under the New Testament, when Christ the substance was exhibited, the same covenant of grace was and still is to be administered in the preaching of the word,(1) and the administration of the sacraments of baptism(2) and the Lord's Supper;(3) in which grace and salvation are held forth in more fulness, evidence, and efficacy, to all nations.(4) (1)Mark 16:15 (2)Matt. 28:19,20 (3)1 Cor. 11:23,24,25 (4)2 Cor. 3:6-18; Heb. 8:6,10,11; Matt. 28:19

Matthew 26:26-28 Jesus took bread, and after blessing it broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, "Take, eat; this is my body." ²⁷And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you, ²⁸for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

Call to Faithfulness, Repentance & Confession - Hebrews 12:1-6, 11-14

ESV ...let us ... lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ² looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. ³ Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted. ⁴ In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. ⁵ And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him. ⁶ For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives."... ¹¹ For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. ¹² Therefore lift your drooping hands and strengthen your weak knees, ¹³ and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be put out of joint but rather be healed. ¹⁴ Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord.
